US TRUCK SUPPLIER DIVESTS BRAZILIAN INTERESTS

Araújo e Policastro Advogados has helped US truck supplier Meritor and its Brazilian subsidiary divest their interest in a local joint venture.

The companies sold a 49 per cent stake in suspension manufacturer Suspensys to their JV partner Randon, a highway and auto parts manufacturer, which relied on its in-house counsel for the sale, and on Vieira, Rezende, Barbosa e Guerreiro Advogados for antitrust matters.

The US\$195 million deal was completed on 30 July.
